### What aspect of your job is the most challenging?

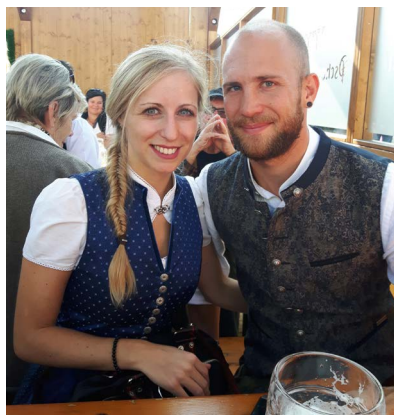
Waiting for the delivery of a part we need, while managing to stay on our own aircraft delivery schedule.
